#### **FISHERMEN TAB:**

This project is the part of Skill Development initiatives of CIDC for the entire coastal community. In this project a special TAB with MIS software will be created and provided to our coastal area fishermen. It has been long felt that the new technology should be made available to our fishermen at an affordable price in order to elevate them from their present condition. The use of GPRS with basic training to the fishermen about its handling will not only help to enhance their livelihood but also will give a boost to the economy in terms of higher export of fisheries products. Through the effective use of navigational equipment, the problem of crossing the international water will also be rectified up to some extent. The use of technology will play a major role for the development of our fishermen community.



The TAB will contain dedicated software facilitating the key features as mentioned below.

- Key Personnel information of the fishermen i.e. Profiling of the entire fishermen community
- The software will be integrated with the Aadhar Card
- The software will be integrated with the Bank accounts
- The software will be integrated with the insurance covers and policies with all the facilities of online payments

- Health Schemes
- Housing Schemes
- Fish Stoke management will be online for facilitating the sale / purchase
- The details of all the family members of a fishermen will be online
- The health information of all the family members will be online
